- 1. This memorandum is to clarify the North Carolina Air National Guard Records Retrieval policy.
- 2. Current members of the North Carolina Air National Guard will comply with the following records retrieval policy: In order to request personnel records, members will contact their servicing Force Support Squadron.
- 3. As prescribed by the Standard Form 180, Requests Pertaining to Military Records, retired or separated members of the North Carolina Air National Guard will comply with the following retrieval procedure: Records can be obtained by contacting the National Personnel Records Center at 1 Archives Drive, St. Louis, MO 63138 or fax a standard form 180 to 314-801-9195.
